The domain name system (DNS) is a unique identifier for each computer on the Internet. It is constructed from a hierarchy of domains (top-level domains, second-level domains, etc.).

Domain names are registered with a domain name registry, which is generally one of several top-level domain (gTLD) registries. The registry of a domain name (cTLD), usually a first-service provider, is responsible for the registration of domain names. Some registries have few restrictions, while others have special requirements.
